1. DASPA expertise : a gentle and effective immersion

Our DASPA programme (Reception and Schooling Programme for Newly Arrived Students) is designed as a true gateway to academic success.

➤ Personalised Teaching Approach

By limiting class sizes to groups of 8 to 12 students, we ensure individualised follow-up. Teachers apply differentiated instruction, adapting each lesson to the learner's pace.

➤ Skill Levels

The DASPA programme is structured into four French proficiency levels, allowing students to validate their learning step by step.

➤ Time for Success

This learning pathway lasts from 6 to 18 months, with exceptional extensions possible, in order to guarantee a solid transition to transition or qualification classes.

➤ Multicultural Richness

With over 60 nationalities already welcomed, our school fosters open-mindedness and learning through human exchange.

2. A Diverse Educational Offer

After DASPA, or through a traditional pathway, the school offers a wide range of options to support each student's academic project :

➤ General and Technical Transition Education, A comprehensive curriculum developing curiosity and analytical rigour, with specialisations in the following fields :

- Sciences and Mathematics
- Modern Languages (Spanish, Chinese)
- Classical Languages (Latin)
- Economics
- Applied Economics
- Social Sciences
- Physical Education

- Qualification education, a curriculum focused on practical and rewarding career pathways, in the following field:
 - Educational Assistant

3. Student life and support services

Student well-being is also supported through streamlined logistics and a healthy environment :

- School Restaurant

The school has an on-site restaurant offering varied meals. For optimal management, access is organised via a reservation system, ensuring smooth service and high-quality organisation.

- Guidance and Health Services

A multidisciplinary team, including educators, a school nurse, a social worker and a psychologist, provides ongoing listening and psychosocial support.

- Sports Facilities

Students benefit from sports facilities within the school as well as access to a high-level sports complex located just a short walk from the campus.
